## Pond Openings and Health

The openings have led to successful flushes and short-term improvements in several testing parameters, but unfortunately the regular openings are not leading to sustained improved health for the Pond according to test results. As you will hear from representatives of the Chilmark Pond Foundation at the Annual Meeting, the project to improve the ecological health of the Pond for fish habitat should be submitted to the authorities for review soon. It is my understanding that there will be public information meetings about the proposed project and we will make sure that the Pond Association members are informed about those meetings. There have been delays due to the pandemic.
